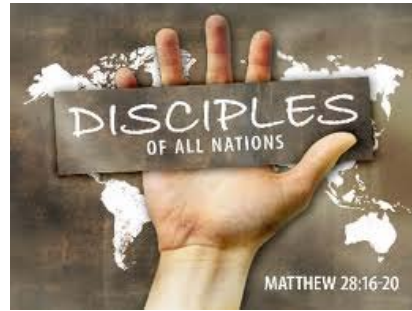

Sandi Niven came to Scotland 9 years ago in response to a call from God to minister in Aberdeen. As a prophet she felt part of her role would be to encourage prophetic ministry in the city and her first year or so was spent getting to know the city, its churches and ministers.

This was a testing time for her as she found difficulty in gaining acceptance but little by little, under the hand of God, her ministry became known and welcomed and doors opened to her. As well as setting up her own prophetic school she ministered increasingly in different churches including those without an overt charismatic ministry. At the same time Sandi regularly visited the U.S. as well as other countries.

For the majority of her time here she made New Life International Church her spiritual home where she both ministered and was part of the fellowship. Now

God has spoken again and has told her that her time here is at an end. Responding to His call, as she has always done, Sandi is moving to the United States where, during her first months she will be seeking to find more of God's will about where and how she is to be ministering in that huge nation.
